 - The Eighth College Academic Plan workgroup is meeting this fall. Eighth College is projected to be up and running for Fall 2023.
- Workgroup on Distance Education for Academic Excellence and Resilience
 - The Senate workgroup has been meeting over the past year. The team has been examining remote and online teaching, and will be submitting recommendations on R-courses, emergency remote instruction, possible expanded remote offerings, resources/trainings for faculty, and online programs to the Senate this fall.
 - Recent discussions have included looking closely at Summer Session. With over a 30% increase in Summer Session enrollments the past few years, this workgroup is discussing how the Policy on Distance Education might be amended to possibly allow expanded remote options (i.e., beyond R-courses) during Summer Session.
